# (The big idea – our life experience is mostly directly related to our choices and we have the power to choose well through the Holy Spirit)

## Title: `Everything happens for a reason!

When I hear this I wonder if they mean some kind of a new age thought?

- our destiny is left in the wisdom of the "universe"
- -go with the flow of the river somewhere at the end is where our destiny is
- Possibly I am not really responsible for the thing happen in my life

## True: - Everything does happen for a reason

Comes down to basic cause and effect

There are things in our lives that are out of our control,

- Ecc. Says time and chance happen to them all.
- sometimes our lives are directly effected by **choices** or actions of others.
- Natural disasters & accidents
- Many potential causes

However, Good news

Many times – perhaps Most times the Reason things happen in our life is directly related to the **choices** we have made

(implies we do have some control)

### Our power to choose

What does the bible says about our power to choose

and effect the direction of our lives?

God's instruction to Israel Duet 30/19 -

<sup>&</sup>quot;Everything happens for a reason"

"Behold I lay before you life and death, Therefore **Choose** life that you and your offspring may live!"

- God has given mankind the freedom to choose
- We give direction to our lives through our choices
- Our choices have the potential to lead toward life or death

#### Duet 28 demonstrates-

Gets very specific .....

Starts with If you obey the Lord your God – choose life!

first 14 vrs.

Blessed will you be in the city, the country,

the fields, your kneading bowl and your womb etc. (vrs 1-14)

- Next 50 or so vrs - However if you don't choose well — you will experience curses and consequences

## Our choices effect our outcomes

Our God given power to **choose** is an important key to how we experience life.

even when "chance" happens, we can choose how we will respond.

(make lemonade out of lemons)

My experience (how a bad decision led to bad outcomes)

(Sickness and bitterness story.)

Bible says - Bitterness rots the bones choosing death

Also says - Laugher is good medicine The joy of the Lord is my strength

Choices for life-giving responses – experience good outcomes.

How we choose to respond to our circumstances has consequences for life or death

## what did Jesus say about the life he died for us to have

John 10/10

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

2 options life or death

Abundant...

Greek – concordance – (4053) super abound in excess, superabundant in quantity, or superior in quality. Exceeding abundantly, advantage, exceeding very high, beyond measure, superfluous (surplus, more than enough), vehemently (in a <u>forceful</u>, passionate, or intense manner; with great feeling)

Amplified: <sup>10</sup> The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have **and enjoy life**, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

- Jesus wants us to enjoy an abundant life
- The enemy came to Steal Kill and destroy
- The agenda of the enemy, and Jesus Agenda for us
- Choose which one to follow

## The challenge - The War

- We are living in a war between good and evil,
- Battle ground for us- in the mind -ability to make right choices
- we have an enemy who is constantly wanting to undermine and come against us, tempting us to choose badly

- Cartoon devil/angel bottom line How will you chose
- HS and devil vying for control of your mind.

## 1 Peter 5:8 (amplified)

Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert and cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

## But.... 1 John 4:4

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because **He who is** in you **is greater** than **he who is** in the world.

We have the ability to win that war and choose well through Christ

- So... everything happens for a reason and not always, but very often it is related to the choices we make.
- God has given us the freedom and power to choose
- Jesus wants us to enjoy the abundant life.
- But ... we are in a daily battle in our mind where the spirit of God is calling us to choose well, and the enemy is tempting us to that which will ultimately lead to steal, kill and destroy.

#### How do we win this battle in our minds

- Zechariah 4:6 -'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty.
- Gal 5:16 <sup>16</sup> I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

HS will help us to make good choices in the heat of the battle and in our daily walk.

## How do we engage the fullness of the HS in our lives

Eph. 5:18 - Don't be drunk with wine, but be filled with the spirit.

- Give control of your life to God
